



Caravan and Camping Emergency Action Card

What to do in an Emergency at Spirit Energy Barrow On-Shore Terminals

If you receive a warning of a major incident or hear the site emergency siren (continuous tone) or community alarm (warbling tone) remain calm and follow this advice:

GO IN, STAY IN, TUNE IN

1. Find a place to shelter

Ideally find a brick building nearby in which to shelter (this could be a club house) Otherwise shelter in your caravan. Sheltering under canvas will not offer the same protection

2. Try not to use mobile telephones


Unless you need urgent help.

- Listen to local radio and monitor social media BBC Radio Cumbria FM: 96.1 MHz, MW 837KHz Heart FM: 96.9 MHz

- 4. Do not attempt to leave the area
- 5. Follow Emergency Services advice

Additional Information

GO INDOORS AND STAY THERE

If you are sheltering in a building or caravan close doors and windows. Close curtains and blinds and shelter at the opposite side of the building or caravan to the Spirit Energy Terminals. Keep away from windows to avoid danger from flying glass, and under no circumstances go outside where you could be in danger of being caught in an explosion.

DO NOT TO USE MOBILE PHONES (unless you need urgent help)

In an emergency all telephone systems may become overloaded and this may prevent emergency calls getting through. If you must make a call, please use a landline phone and be brief or send a mobile text message. Please do not make mobile telephone calls.

LISTEN TO LOCAL RADIO & MONITOR SOCIAL MEDIA

The Emergency Services will broadcast information and advice on local radio, including confirmation that the emergency is over.

LET SOMEONE KNOW YOU ARE SAFE

If you can text or email someone to let them know you are safe, then do so. Avoid using mobile phones for calls unless urgent.

FOLLOW EMERGENCY SERVICES ADVICE

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO LEAVE THE AREA

Remain in shelter. There could be serious traffic congestion and you will be much safer indoors. Only leave the area if you are advised to do so by the emergency services.

EVACUATION

If evacuation is required then the Emergency Services will notify the site of which Reception Centre you should travel to in order to register.
