



School Emergency Action Card

What to do in an Emergency at Spirit Energy Barrow On-Shore Terminals

If you receive a warning of a major incident or hear the site emergency siren (continuous tone) or community alarm (warbling tone) remain calm and follow this advice:

GO IN, STAY IN, TUNE IN

1. Go inside and close doors and windows

Shut down ventilation and air conditioning systems. Close curtains/blinds and shelter in a room on the opposite side of the building to the Spirit Energy Terminals.



2. Try not to use mobile telephones

Unless you need urgent help.

Additional Information

GO INDOORS AND STAY THERE

Close all doors and windows. Close curtains and blinds and shelter in a room on the opposite side of the building to the Spirit Energy Terminals. Keep away from windows to avoid danger from flying glass, and under no circumstances go outside where you could be in danger of being caught in an explosion.

EVACUATION

If an evacuation is required Westmorland and Furness Council may organise transport. All staff and pupils, and any parents, must go to a Reception Centre to be registered. Take the School Attendance Register with you.

DO NOT TO USE MOBILE PHONES (unless you need urgent help)

In an emergency all telephone systems may become overloaded and this may prevent emergency calls getting through. If you must make a call, please use a landline phone and be brief or send a mobile text message. Please do not make mobile telephone calls.

TUNE IN TO LOCAL RADIO AND MONITOR SOCIAL MEDIA

The Emergency Services will broadcast information and advice on local radio, including confirmation that the emergency is over.
