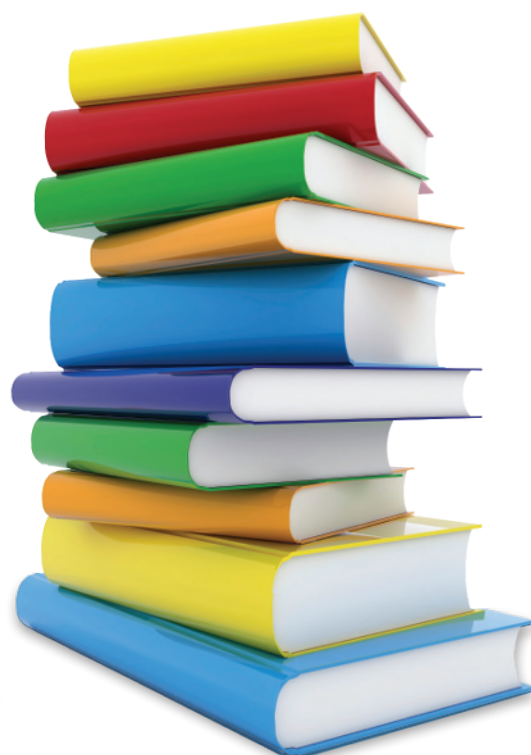
Book Banding

Book banding is a method of grading the reading level of a book. Books can be graded from the simplest texts, suitable for very early readers, to books for fluent readers allowing you to monitor progression and achievement.
