

Cumbria County Council has **secured £102m** from the Government to fund the scheme and help support St Cuthbert's Garden Village.

The Carlisle Southern Link Road will join the A595 at Newby West to the M6 at Junction 42. Subject to planning permission, we aim to build the road from **spring 2021 to 2023**.



The 8 km long 60 mph road will include four new roundabouts, five cycle bridges and four road bridges. A cycle path is provided on the northern side along its full length.

This consultation seeks your views on the improvements made to the scheme since the last public consultation.


